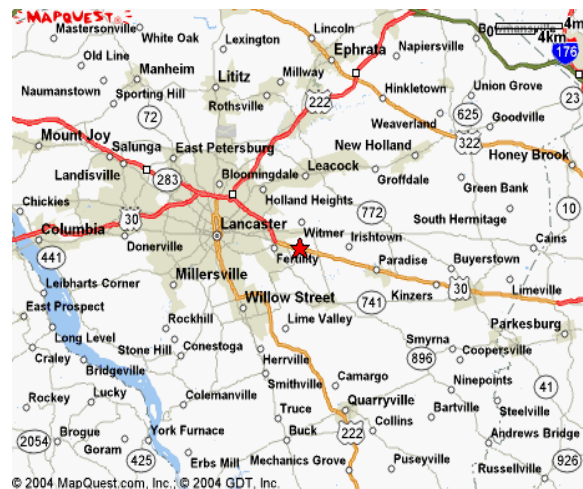

## "The Magic of Stephen" featuring Stephen Bargatze

Stephen Bargatze has been performing his unique style of magic and comedy for all types of audiences for more than 20 years. Over those two decades, Stephen has earned numerous awards and recognitions. During his presentation, Stephen addresses underage drinking, driving under the influence, and other drug problems that face the youth of today. The most powerful aspect of his presentation is when he shares his life story with the audience. Stephen grew up in an alcoholic family, which challenged him throughout his life. Though faced with obstacles, Stephen was able to overcome his difficulties by changing his attitude and respecting the adults in his life. Stephen will amaze as well as entertain you. This is a program you don't want to miss.

**"The Party Road" (Jim bender and Stephanie C. Roy, Council on Drug and Alcohol Abuse, Lancaster County)** - Through interactive activities and discussions, students will learn about the consequences of drug and alcohol use and misuse, and will come to understand the difference between use, abuse, and dependency. Students will also learn about the effects that different substances have on the brain and their ability to think.

**IMPACT PANEL** – A panel of victims and offenders will speak briefly about the alcohol impaired crashes and incidents in which they or a loved one was injured or killed. They simply tell their stories—what their lives were like before the crash and how their lives and families have been affected since. The victims and offenders speak from the heart about the pain and suffering drunk driving can cause and imprint images of real people, which may replay when drinking and driving choices are made. This panel is offered to change behavior and save lives.

**"Consequences of an Underage Drinking or DUI Arrest"** (Officer Tim Biggins, Adams County) - This workshop will provide students with a complete overview of an underage drinking and/or DUI arrest. Among the topics covered will be apprehension, field sobriety testing, and legal issues as they relate to implied consent and evidentiary testing. In addition to allowing time for questions, Officer Biggins will describe sobriety checkpoints and roving DUI patrols, and give a brief demonstration of K-9 procedures with the help of his drug-sniffing German Shepherd "Max."

**Advisors:** You may want to remind your students about the presence of a drug-sniffing dog at this year's conference.
